Suspect, DOB 01/01/1980 (barcode 95012345).</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: The subject sample (barcode 95012345) is a 'pre-PACE' sample that can only be used for intelligence purposes. If there is sufficient appropriate, supporting information to arrest the subject on the basis of this DNA match, the subject can be re-sampled using the PACE DNA Sampling kit and a further DNA profile obtained that is suitable for evidential comparison.</p>
