SUSPECT were compared in detail to the footwear marks recorded at The Address, items QWE/1 and 2. The marks correspond with the submitted footwear in terms of pattern, size, pattern configuration and the general degree of wear.</p> <p>Shoes with this undersole pattern have been encountered on numerous occasions amongst footwear seen by (FSP/Force) in the last year. Nevertheless, this particular pattern type is just one of a vast number of undersole patterns currently available on shoes.</p>
